



BRETT BUTLER STEPS OUT FROM THE SHADOWS

After a Triumphant Race at Daytona Fuel Doctor Driver Butler Takes the Stage

(Tuesday February 16, 2010) – Daytona, FL – After an impressive race at Daytona in The NextEra Energy Resources 250, Brett Butler has undeniably hit his stride in the racing world. Placing 11th in the season opener, on-lookers were in awe of the 24 year old's level of skill for his first time on a superspeedway in the series. The future looks bright for Butler, as he sets his sights on conquering NASCAR's Camping World Truck Series 2010 season.

Born and raised in Snellville, Georgia, Brett has been racing since the age of fifteen and has worked his way from go-carts to NASCAR's Camping World Truck Series in less than ten years. Last year, Brett raced in the ARCA series at Daytona placing 39th. The younger brother of Ken Butler III, Brett has often been over looked by NASCAR fans, that is sure to change after his strong finish this past weekend.

On Saturday evening, Brett Butler drove the Fuel Doctor #47 truck alongside champions like Ted Musgrave, Kyle Busch and Mike Skinner in the Nextera Energy Resources 250. A part of the Rick Ware Racing team, Brett drove in his 'Fuel Doctor: Go Green Machine' with a clear strategy in mind. Escaping wreck after wreck, Brett started from the 29th position and placed 11th out of 36 drivers, a remarkable feat for his Camping World Series debut. The race marked his career high in NASCAR. To top off the momentous event, Brett was honored with the Raybestos "Rookie of the Race" award. Currently Brett is leading in points for this year's Rookie of the Year championship. "The Nextera Energy Resources 250 was exhilarating and to be recognized with this award was very exciting," stated Butler. "I'm ready for Atlanta" he exclaimed.

In his first year of the 2010 NASCAR Camping World Truck Series Brett is scheduled for 12 races. Next, Brett will take the Fuel Doctor #47 truck to the Atlanta Motor Speedway on March 6th for the Atlanta 200. In his hometown of Atlanta, Brett, will be up against Bass Pro Shops driver Austin Dillon. Austin is currently running for this years "Rookie of the Year" as well. What a race this will be.
